REESIE'S HOLIDAY RECIPES



Fluffy Fruit Salad

Ingredients

- 2 (8 oz.) light cream cheese
- 1 (16 oz.) can lite fruit cocktail
- 1 (16 oz.) can pineapple
- 1 (16 oz.) can lite peaches
- 1/2 jar maraschino cherries, cut in half
- 1 (8 oz.) container of light Cool Whip
- 1 c. powdered sugar

Beat cream cheese and sugar with mixer. Stir in defrosted Cool Whip and well drained fruit. Refrigerate.

Double Layer Pineapple Upside Down Cake

- 1 jar maraschino cherries, drained
- 1/4 cup butter
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup flaked coconut
- 1 (8 ounce) can sliced pineapple, drained with juice reserved
- 1 (8 ounce) can crushed pineapple, drained with juice reserved
- 1 (18.25 ounce) package yellow cake mix

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Coat the bottoms and sides of each 9 inch round cake pan with 2 tablespoons of melted butter. Sprinkle the bottom of each pan with 1/4 cup of brown sugar. In one of the pans, sprinkle coconut over the brown sugar. Lay pineapple rings in a single layer on top of coconut. Place a cherry in the center of each ring. In the other pan, spread the drained crushed pineapple. Mix the cake as directed on package, but substitute reserved pineapple juice in place of water. Divide batter between the 2 pans. Remember which pan has the pineapple rings in it. Bake for 40 to 50 minutes in the preheated oven, or until a toothpick inserted into cake comes out clean. Cool in pans for 20 minutes. While the bottoms of the cake pans are still warm to the touch, turn the layer with the crushed pineapple out onto a serving dish, then gently lay the layer with the pineapple rings on top of the first layer with pineapple rings facing up.

Chuckwagon Soup

Ingredients

- 2 slices bacon, diced
- 2 pounds ground beef
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 1 cup chopped celery
- 3 medium carrots, thinly sliced
- 2 cups beef broth
- 2 cans (14.5 ounces each) diced tomatoes in juice
- 1 can whole kernel corn, drained
- 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 2 cans (15 ounces each) beans (pinto, great northern, small red, or mixture), drained

Cook bacon in skillet until crisp; remove bacon with a slotted spoon to paper towels to drain. To the drippings, add beef, chopped onion, celery. Cook, stirring, until beef is browned. Put in a large pan. Add the carrots, beef broth, tomatoes, corn, Worcestershire sauce, salt, and pepper. Bring to a boil; reduce heat to low, cover, and simmer for 30 minutes, or until vegetables are tender. Add the drained beans. Taste and add pepper and more salt, if necessary. Simmer for about 15 minutes longer.

Chili Man Chili

Ingredients

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 cup sweet onion, chopped
- 1/2 cup green pepper, chopped
- 2 cans (15 ounce size) chili beans
- 1 can (14.5 ounce size) diced tomatoes
- 1 can (6 ounce size) tomato paste
- 1 can Green Giant Mexicorn
- 1/2 cup ketchup
- 1/2 cup water
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 tablespoon chili powder
- 2 teaspoons oregano
- 1 teaspoon sugar

In large pan, cook beef, onion and green pepper until meat is browned. Drain excess grease. Stir in remaining ingredients, except cheese. Bring to boil. Cover, reduce heat to low and simmer for 20 minutes.

Peanut Butter Brownie Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 (19.5 ounce) package Pillsbury Brownie Classics Traditional Fudge Brownie Mix
- 1/4 cup butter or margarine, melted
- 1 (4 ounce) package cream cheese, softened
- 1 egg
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1 cup creamy peanut butter
- 1/2 (16 ounce) can chocolate frosting

Heat oven to 350 degrees. In medium bowl, beat brownie mix, melted butter, cream cheese and egg 50 strokes with spoon until well blended (dough will be sticky). Drop dough by rounded tablespoonfuls 2 inches apart onto ungreased cookie sheets to make 24 cookies; smooth edge of each to form round cookie. In small bowl, mix powdered sugar and peanut butter with spoon until mixture forms a ball. With hands, roll rounded teaspoonfuls peanut butter mixture into 24 balls. Lightly press 1 ball into center of each ball of dough. Bake at 350 degrees F for 10 to 14 minutes or until edges are set. Cool on cookie sheets at least 30 minutes.

Fiesta Cornbread

Ingredients

- 1 cup butter, melted
- 1 cup white sugar
- 4 eggs
- 1 (15 ounce) can cream-style corn
- 1/2 (4 ounce) can chopped green chile peppers, drained
- 1/2 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese
- 1/2 cup shredded Cheddar cheese
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 cup yellow cornmeal
- 4 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt

Preheat oven to 300 degrees. Lightly grease a 9x13 inch baking dish. In a large bowl, beat together butter and sugar. Beat in eggs one at a time. Blend in cream corn, chiles, Monterey Jack and Cheddar cheese. In a separate bowl, stir together flour, cornmeal, baking powder and salt. Add flour mixture to corn mixture; stir until smooth. Pour batter into prepared pan. Bake in preheated oven for 1 hour, until a toothpick inserted into center of the pan comes out clean.
