"The burden which Habakkuk the prophet did see." Habakkuk 1:1 (KJV)

One of the hardest things I've faced, is to be awakened from a warm and restful sleep to the stark, cold direction of the Lord concerning His people - especially when He gives me a message of rebuke and reproof. Christians often forget that we are bought with a price and that we are not our own. We "live fat" and "play hard", and have an "eat, drink, and be merry" mentality that easily leaves no time for the study of the WORD and hearkening to the voice of God. We are long on what's in it for me, and short on what I can give to others or do for others. Too many clichés? Well, what does the WORD say? It says that in the last days, men will be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. Many in the church of today have looked for and been the fulfillment of that prophecy in 1 Corinthians 13 that says, "... but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away." That's not the Lord's doing! FAR FROM IT! If your study the text you will find that this is speaking of the frailty of man, not the fading away of the Lord. It is the frailty of a humanity of people who in these last days, no longer seek God, but they seek what is good for themselves instead. They no longer study nor quote the tenets of the faith, but declare that they are instead, writing them. "This is a NEW ERA" they announce, "...and God is doing a new thing!" Well, I think that's great as long as they don't forget He still stands by The OLD THINGS HE SAID. Such things as the Ten Commandments and His commandment to Israel saying, "Thou shalt Love the Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:" Deuteronomy 6:4-6 (KJV) What has happened my friend? Where are the Lovers of The Lord who will not compromise with the world; Where are those who are not just a lip-service when the worship leader says, "come on let's worship", but they love the Lord with all of their heart and all of their soul and with all of their might during the tough times? “Let My People Go

And afterward Moses and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Let my people go, that they may hold a feast unto me in the wilderness. And Pharaoh said, Who is the LORD, that I should obey his voice to let Israel go? I know not the LORD; neither will I let Israel go. Exodus 5:1-2

The message is the same today, but the bondage and chains have changed. In other words the message is the same but the game changed. Pharaoh still exists today and is tormenting God's people in every way. He wears a different cloak with a different mask today. You can recognize Pharaoh by his stubbornness to hear the Word and be obedient to the will of God. Yes, Pharaoh is still alive and well. Pharaoh still wants total control of our lives. He wants to steal our inner happiness, peace, joy and kill our will power to move beyond the chains of despair to the place of hope where God wants us be. That place, that Promised Land, that place God promises for each of us, which is our Canaan Land that flows with milk and honey. (opportunities and promises) Yes, Pharaoh wants to destroy any resemblance we may have of our Father and His hope for us. He wants to carve out that creation image of truth, which is we are created in the image of God. Pharaoh thinks he is all of that and a bag of chips, but God is The Great I Am. He is God and He alone must be served! Have you told Pharaoh to “LET MY PEOPLE GO” yet? To let you go, yet? You are God's people!!! The Bible says in: Deuteronomy 28:12-14 - 12The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow. 13And the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the commandments of the LORD thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them: 14And thou shalt not go aside from any of the words which I command thee this day, to the right hand, or to the left, to go after other gods to serve them. Three questions to see if you are being tested: Has Pharaoh put undue stress and pressure on you? Are you worried or feel uncertain about the direction you are going? Are you weighed down with life issues? Is your body and mind is working day and night just to make it another day? If you answered yes, yes, yes then Old Pharaoh is allowed to reign king of your life. There can be only one king in your life and that is the King of Kings, Jesus Christ. The bible says' Philippians 2:9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: 10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; 11And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Remember Pharaoh must be dethroned out of our lives that Jesus can be enthroned in us. As we have learned in the bible Pharaoh wont go anywhere without a fight. He must be totally defeated and subdued in each of our lives. Listen to this; 10 Plagues: 1. The first plague was the plague of blood: Here God instructed Moses to hit his staff on the river and caused the River Nile and all the waters of Egypt, canals, marshes, reservoirs and water stored in homes to turn into blood. Aaron used his own staff to point at the waters of Egypt. All the fishes in the Nile died and the water became bitter. People could not drink the water again. The Egyptians magicians also turned water to blood to show their own strength. (Exodus 7:14-25.) 2. The plaque of frogs. When the plague of blood was over Pharaoh promised letting go the Israelites God sent vast hordes of frogs across entire land of Egypt. The River Nile, swamps, houses, bedrooms and even beds, household utensils was full with frogs. (Exodus 8:1-14) 3. The plague of gnats. Here the Lord asked Moses to command Aaron to strike the dust with his shepherd staff and the dust will turn into swarms of gnats. He did and all the dust in Egypt turned into swarms of gnats. (Exodus 8:16-19) 4. When Pharaoh still did not want to release the Israelites God sent the plague of flies to cover the whole of Egypt. This plague was terrible and Pharaoh accepted Moses to offer sacrifice to the God of Israel. At the end he still refused to allow them to leave Egypt. (Exodus 8:20-30.) 5. The plague against livestock: Here God sent a plague to kill all the animals like cattle, sheep etc... of Egypt. This happened just the next day but Pharaoh was still very stubborn. (Exodus 9:1-7) 6. A plague of boils: God commanded Moses to take soot from a furnace and toss it into the sky in the watchful eyes of pharaoh. The effect was an outbreak of boils that attacked all the Egyptians and the animals. Even the Egyptian magicians could not move as they were all covered with boils. Yet pharaoh refused to let go the Israelites. (Exodus 9:8-12.) 7. The plague of hail: God commanded Moses and Aaron to lift up their staffs towards heaven for Him to send thunder and hail. They did and he sent thunder and hail accompanied by lightening struck the earth. It was a tremendous hail storms against the land of Egypt which was the first in the history of mankind. Pharaoh after pleading to Moses to pray God to stop it still refused to allow the Israelites to leave Egypt. (Exodus 9:13-31.)8. The plague of locust was sent by God to invade the land of Egypt. Even Egyptian officials pleaded Pharaoh to allow Israelites go, yet Pharaoh could not listen to his officials. (Exodus 10:1-18.)...*continued on page 4*

The plague of darkness: God sent a plague of terrifying darkness to Egypt to show pharaoh that he is the God of Israel so that he should be convince and allow the Israelites go. Still he did not. (Exodus 10:21-29.) 10. Death for the Egyptian's first born: This was the last plague. Here the first born of each family was going to die and even the first born of their animals was to die.. This was so heart-breaking to pharaoh yet he refuses letting go of the Israelites. There will be many spiritual battles on the way to your promised land so as Paul admonished them in: Ephesians 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. 11Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. 13Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. 17And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Pharaoh's army got drowned in the red sea because; The Lord told Moses what to do, To lead the Hebrew children through, As Israel stood by the waterside, At God's command it did divide, Pharaoh said he'd go across, But Pharaoh and his hosts were lost, Your foes shall not before you stand, And you'll possess your promise land, O let us all from bondage flee, And let us all in Christ be free, Jesus is the Savior and has come to set us free from Pharaoh and to give us life more abundantly. Do you know him? I invite you to come to know Jesus today. Oh what a friend He is and will be to you.. REESIE'S RECIPES



Cinnamon Crisp Tortillas

Ingredients

- 2 medium fat-free flour tortilla(s)
- 2 tsp reduced-calorie margarine
- 1/2 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp sugar

Preheat broiler. Arrange tortillas on nonstick baking sheet. Brush each tortilla with 1/4 of the margarine and sprinkle with 1/4 of the cinnamon. Broil on lowest rack until margarine is bubbly, 1 to 2 minutes. Combine remaining cinnamon with sugar. Turn tortillas over, brush each with half of remaining margarine, then sprinkle each with sugar remaining sugar-cinnamon mixture. Broil until cinnamon-sugar mixture caramelizes, about 1 minute.

Reece's Cup Pie

CAKE:

- 1 1/2 c. half and half
 - 1 pkg. 4 serving size instant chocolate pudding
 - 3 1/2 c. Cool Whip (8 oz. size)
 - 1 c. Reese's peanut butter cups (chopped)
 - 1 chocolate graham cracker crust
- Beat half and half and pudding mix for 1 minute. Let stand 5 minutes. Stir in Cool Whip and Reese's cups. Pour mixture into crust. Cover and store in freezer overnight.

Twice-Baked Mashed Potatoes

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 1/2 cup chopped green pepper
- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- 4 cups mashed potatoes (prepared with milk and butter)
- 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese, divided
- 1/4 cup crumbled cooked bacon
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper

In a small skillet, saute onion and green pepper in oil until tender. In a large bowl, combine the onion mixture, mashed potatoes, 1/2 cup cheese, bacon, salt and pepper. Spoon into a greased 2-qt. baking dish. Sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake, uncovered, at 350 degrees for 20-25 minutes or until cheese is melted.

Cheesy Chicken Enchilada Casserole

Ingredients

- 2 green and/or red peppers, diced, 2 cups.
- 1 small onion, 2/3 of a cup
- 1 tablespoon chili powder.
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1 can (14.5 ounces) diced tomatoes, drained
- 2 tablespoons tomato paste
- 2 lbs. (3 cups) cooked skinless boneless chicken breast
- 1 jar (16 ounces) salsa
- 4 (10 inch) flour tortillas
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- Sour cream, sliced jalapeno peppers

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Coat large nonstick skillet with cooking spray; heat over medium heat. Add peppers, onion, chili powder, salt, and pepper; cook, stirring often, until softened, about 3 minutes. Add tomatoes, 1 cup water, tomato paste; cook 5 minutes. In large bowl combine chicken and tomato mixture. Spread 1/2 of a cup of salsa in ungreased 13"X9" baking dish; top with 2 tortillas. Top with chicken mixture; sprinkle with 1/2 of a cup of cheese. Top with remaining tortillas. Spread with remaining salsa; sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake until cheese is melted, 15 minutes. If desired, garnish with sour cream and jalapenos.
